

Annual Report of Women's Studies Centre – 2015-16

Following activities were conducted in the Academic year – 2015-16

1. *Ya Haluvar Vayashi Julvun Ghetana 30.08.2015*

One Day Counseling Program was arranged by the Dayanand Girls Hostel Committee under Women's Studies Centre on 30.08.2015. Social activist Mrs. Kumudini Bhargav was invited as the key speaker (Chief Guest) of the program. More than three hundred hostel inmates participated.

2. ***Free Medical Check Up Camp*** – 05.09.2015 – Dayanand Education Society arranged the free Health Check-up Camp at Dayanand girls Hostel. Haemogram Blood Test (SBC) and CBC test were conducted for five hundred students, the Camp was taken for one week. On 5th Sep 2015 the Camp was inaugurated at 9.30 am at the reading room of Girls Hostel. Blood samples were collected by the organization invited. The Program was conducted by Dayanand Education Society, Women's Studies Centre and Latur Obstetrics Gynaecological Society.

3. ***Medical awareness Programme at Girls Hostel. Dt. 13/ 09/2015*** - Mega event of Medical Awareness program was conducted by the Dayanand Education Society and Women's Studies Centre at Girls Hostel on 13.09.2015 from 9.00am to 5.00pm. More than Ten well known doctors were invited to conduct Medical Check up of girls inmates and to deliver lectures on various health issues. Lectures were delivered on following issue – Breast Cancer, Survival Cancer, Haemoglobin Deficiency, PCOS, and so on

4. *19.10.2015 – Meditation towards Peace and Happiness* -

Chief Guest – Dr. Hajgude Varsha(M.B.B.S., MS, MCH). Meditation program was arranged under Women's Studies Centre and Human Rights Education Centre on 19th October 2015 at 11.00am at Seminar Hall. Dr. Hajgude Varsha, MBBS, MS, MCH was invited as the Chief Guest of the Program. She delivered the keynote address.

5. ***The Legal Aid Camp – Nalegaon – 06.02.2016***

The Camp was conducted by LL.B-II and BSL-IV students under the guidance of in charge Miss. Poonam Nathani at village Nalegaon on 06.02.2016. They conducted legal surveys and performed legal awareness skits for the villagers. Adv. Shri. Annarao Patil, Gram Panchyat Members were the guests of the Program. Dramas and skits on the Legal issue were played by our students.

6. ***Medical Awareness Program on Polycystic Ovarian Syndromes 10.02.2016 - Women's Studies Centre of the College in Collaboration with Yuvti Kalyan Mandal of Sister Institutions organized a medical awareness program on Polycystic Ovarian Syndromes by Gynaecologist Dr. Snehal Deshmukh and Dr. Anuja Kulkarni on 10th February 2016. The Program was specially arranged for Girl students of all the colleges of Dayanand Education Society, Latur.***

7. ***Legal Literacy Program at Harangul (Bu) Latur – 23.02.2016.*** – Under the Human Rights Education centre Prof. G.G.Panchal and Prof. P.P.Nathani conducted one day Legal Literacy Program at Harangul on 23.02.2016. The Students of LL.B-II and BSL-IV played Dramas and Skits on various Socio Legal issues such as Andhshradha, Farmer Suicide, Domestic Violence and Human Trafficking. Various Lectures were delivered by the students on contemporary issues. More than 200 students participated in the Camp.

8. **Socio-Legal surveys** – Socio-Legal Surveys were conducted at the villages Nalegaon and Harangul, Dist. Latur. Student volunteers collected the information and the problems of villagers with regard to women related issues. The problems were discussed in the meeting and proper solutions were provided. Through Legal Aid Clinic also legal assistance was provided to the villagers.
