Bicycle Policy

BICYCLE POLICY AND REGULATIONS
FOR
CAMPUS SAFETY AND SECURITY
(Policy Effective from 2nd September 2017)

PURPOSE:

- This procedure is to establish guidelines for the registration, operation, prohibited activities and fines of bicycles in Dayanand College of Law Campus.

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Dayanand College of Law, Latur recognizes that, bicycles are important and legitimate means of transportation, provided they are operated with due regard and concern for the safety of the general public.
- To provide safe and efficient means of managing the large number of bicycles in the campus, all bicycles operated by Dayanand College of Law faculty, staff and students must be registered with the College.
- Dayanand College of Law assumes responsibility for the care and protection of any bicycle, attached accessories, or contents inside the college campus.

STATEMENT

- The purpose of this procedure is to establish guidelines for the registration, operation, prohibited activities, fines and impoundment of bicycles in Dayanand College of Law campus.

BICYCLE REGULATIONS

- The bicycle owner is responsible for complying with all bicycle regulations. Persons operating a bicycle within Dayanand College of Law campus are responsible for acquainting themselves with and obeying the bicycle regulations of the College.
- Bicycles that are bearing the registration label, applied as indicated above, are entitled to use the roadways, sidewalks and bicycle tracks in the campus as specified in these Bicycle Regulations.

OPERATION

- Bicycles and cyclists shall in all respects comply with applicable State laws and regulations, including but not limited to turn signals, lighting, brakes, lane changing, etc.
- Cyclists are responsible for controlling the speed of bicycle so as not to endanger any pedestrian.
- Bicycles parked in the campus must be parked in a bicycle rack.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- No individual shall park, store, or leave a bicycle in such a manner so as to cause said bicycle to block or otherwise obstruct normal entrance to or exit from any building in the campus, or in a manner that constitutes a safety hazard. No individual who operates a bicycle in the campus shall carry and other individual on bicycle.
- Bicycles shall not be parked or stored in a walkway, on a sidewalk, in a hallway, on handicap ramp, or in or near a doorway except where use is made of a parking rack furnished by the College.
- Operating bicycles inside residences or buildings is prohibited. No individual operating a bicycle in campus shall in any way attach it to a moving vehicle. No individual shall operate any bicycle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

FINES

- Citations will be issued to the owner or operator of any bicycle found to be in violation of any bicycle regulation. The fine for violating any of the bicycle regulation of Dayanand College of Law is 100 Rs. for each violation.
