10) National Webinar on ‘Criminal Law and Protection of Women in India’ 25th Feb 2022

The Clinic had conducted the on National Webinar on ‘Criminal Law and Protection of Women in India’ 25th Feb 2022 through Teams app. Dr Shahista Inamdar, Principal I/c, Navjeevan Law College and expert speaker on Women Laws was the resource person who explained legal provisions and case-laws development on the topic. 134 students and 12 teachers attended the webinar



11) Legal Aid Camp at Borwati on 28.05.22

The legal aid clinic conducted the legal aid camp at village Borwati Latur on 28.05.22. All the students of LLB II and BSL IV yr participated in this legal aid camp. In the morning, the camp started with marching of Legal awareness rally throughout the village.
