The Shreya Singhal Vs. Union of India (2015) case is a significant judgement by the Supreme Court of India focusing on free speech and internet freedom. The court struck down section 66A of the Information Technology Act which criminalised, “offensive online messages, as unconstitutional due to vagueness and misuse. The law was found to infringe upon the right to freedom of speech under Article 19(1)(a) and did not meet the reasonable restrictions allowed under Article 19(2).

The judgement classified that law restricting speech must be specific and clearly defined to avoid arbitrary enforcement. The court upheld section 69A and 79 of the IT Act but with safeguards. This ruling reinforced online free speech setting an important precedent for protecting individual rights in the digital age.
