The Justice K.S. Puttaswamy (Retd.) Vs. Union of India (2017) declared that the right to privacy is a fundamental right under the Indian Constitution.

The Supreme Court ruled that privacy is part of the right to life and personal liberty under Article 21. This judgement overruled earlier cases which had denied privacy as a fundamental right. The court clarified that while privacy is essential, it can be restricted if the law serves a legitimate aim, is proportional and follows due process. The ruling laid the groundwork for future data protection laws. Although the judgement did not immediately rule on the Aadhar Scheme, it influenced the legal framework for privacy. It was a landmark decision that affirmed personal autonomy, dignity and privacy in modern India.
