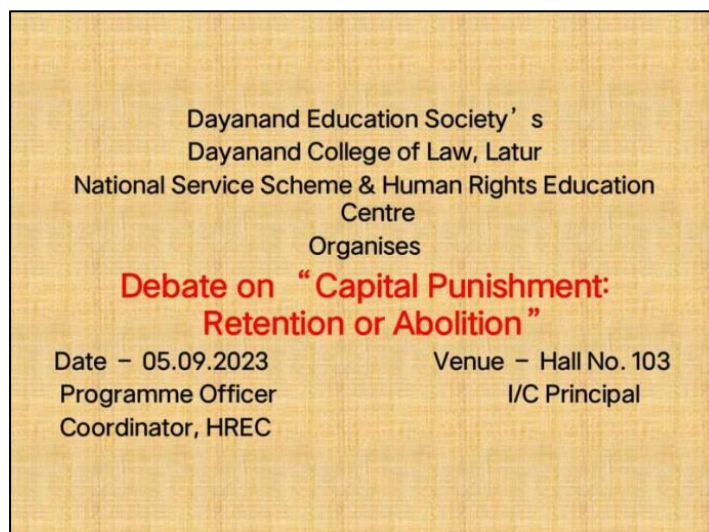

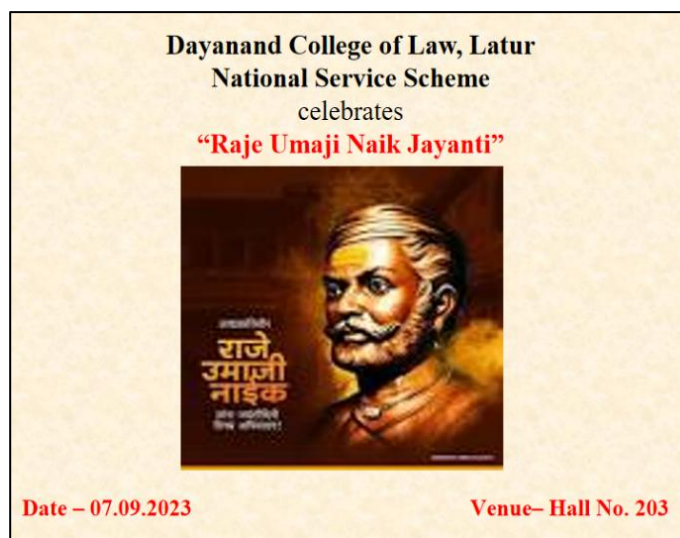

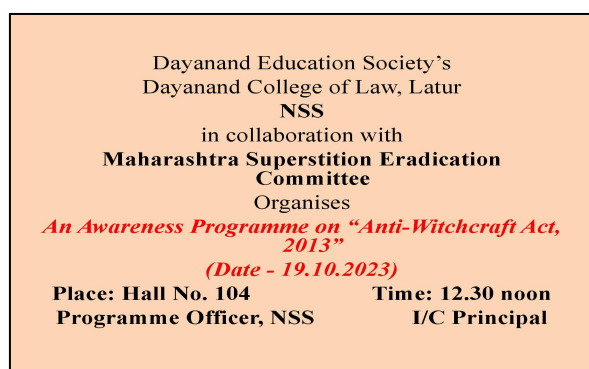

In this programme, the I/C Principal, Faculty members and students were present.

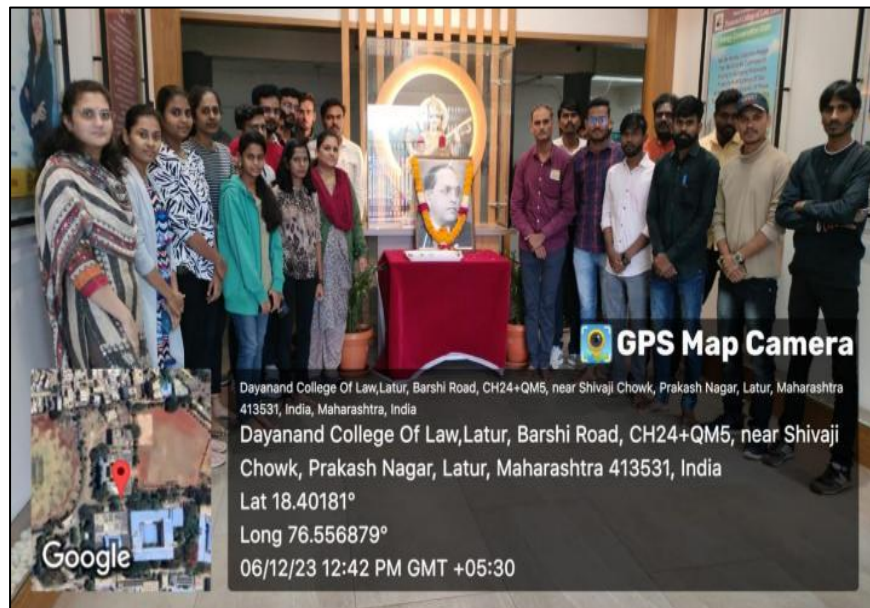

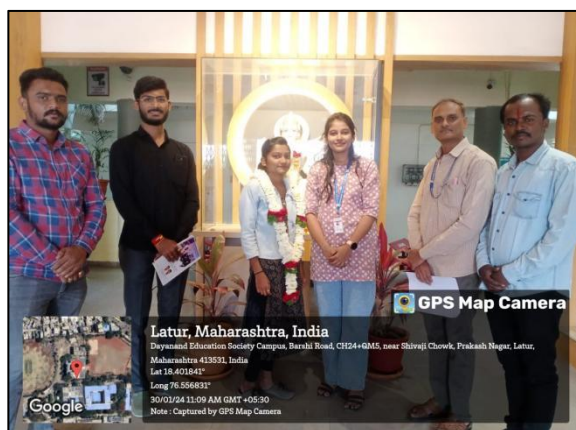
❖ YIN Election (Date -29.01.2024) -

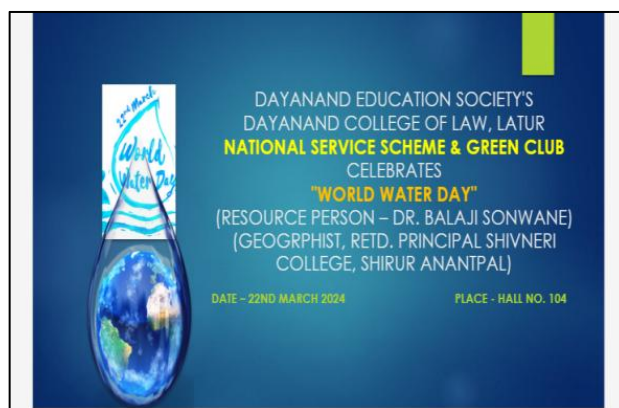

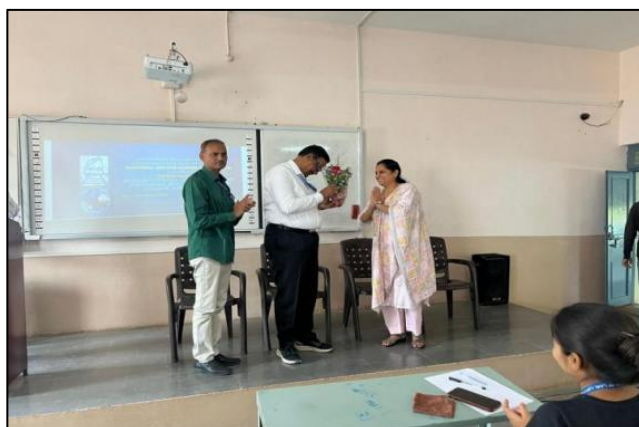
❖ **World Water Day (Date - 22.03.2024) -**
